

## **Notice**

As per the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2017 "that the age cap was not in consonance with BCI's efforts to promote legal education. The Bench stayed BCI's September 7, 2016 notification and further order on this aspect".

The BCI had also capped the students' age at 30 for the three-year law courses and two days ago, had decided to raise it to 45. These orders would also remain stayed by the Supreme Court until the disposal of the cases by aspiring students challenging the validity of the age limits.

Students are eligible to apply for admission to Himachal Pradesh National Law University (HPNLU) 5 Years integrated degree course (B.A./B.B.A. LL.B.) having the age above than 20 years course however, their admission will be subject to outcome of the writ petition which will be placed for the final hearing on third week of July, 2017.
