4. Procedure for Admission.

Admission to the Ph.D. Programme shall be based on the merit list prepared on the basis of applicants' UGC-NET/JRF/Ph.D. scores. All screened applicants shall be required to submit research proposal and make a presentation before the Committee.

5. Coursework.

All Ph.D. scholars have to complete the mandatory course work as prescribed in the HPNLU Regulations for Ph.D. in Law, 2019. Coursework exemption will not be granted under any circumstances.

6. Part Time Ph.D.

50% seats (15 Seat) are reserved for the part time candidates, subject to fulfillment of the following conditions (as mentioned in the UGC Regulations, 2022): -

6.1 Applicant/candidate must be in full time regular employment.

6.2 "No Objection Certificate" from the appropriate authority in the organization where the candidate is employed, clearly stating that:

- (i) The candidate is permitted to pursue studies on a part-time basis.
- (ii) His/her official duties permit/him/her to devote sufficient time for research.
- (iii) If required, he/she will be relieved from the duty to complete the course work.

6.3 The student must have successfully completed the course work prescribed within the duration from the date of his/her registration.

6.4 The maximum duration will be same as per the UGC Regulations, adopted by the University time to time.
