Proviso to Rule 10.5 at page 43 of the Himachal Pradesh National Law University Shimla Regulations for the Doctor of Philosophy Programme in Law, 2019, is to be deleted from Part-III of the said Regulations and be added at the relevant place in Part-IV. the Himachal Pradesh National Law University, Shimla, Examinations Regulations, 2019. The proviso in modified form to be added is as under: 10.5 Provided that the Ph.D. Degree/LL.M. Degree must contain security provisions like provision for photograph and Barcode/Hologram.

Rule. 12.6 The Reports of the Board of Examiners of Viva-Voce shall be submitted to the Vice-Chancellor. Further, if the Reports of the Board of Examiners are positive and recommend the award of Ph.D. Degree then the Vice-Chancellor may, in anticipation of the approval of Academic Council and
