To consider the Representations of Dr. Girjesh Shukla, Associate Professor of Law and Dr. Ruchi Sapahia Associate Professor of Law from Associate Professor Law regarding promotion from (Academic Level 13A) to Professor (Academic Level 14) under Career Advancement Scheme (CAS). [Annexure-III]

The Vice-Chancellor placed before the Executive Council the representations of Dr. Girjesh Shukla, Associate Professor of Law and Dr. Ruchi Sapahia, Associate Professor of Law.

The Vice-Chancellor apprised the members of the Executive Council that Dr. Girjesh Shukla, Associate Professor of Law and Dr. Ruchi Sapahia. Associate Professor of Law had applied for promotion from Associate Professor (Academic Professor Level 13A) to (Academic Level 14) under CAS. The applications were placed before the Screening Committee. As per Rule 7.4 of Himachal Pradesh National Law University Shimla, Service Executive Regulations and 2020 which are in consonance with UGC REGULATIONS ON **MINIMUM** QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT OF **TEACHERS** AND OTHER **ACADEMIC** STAFF IN UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES AND MEASURES FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF **STANDARDS** IN HIGHER

The Executive Council deliberated the matter thoroughly and decided as follows:

- 1. That both of the candidates do possess essential qualifications required the promotion under CAS as per Rules/Regulations of the UGC and the University
- 2. That the conclusion given by the Screening Committee is in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the UGC and that of the relevant rules of the University.
- 3. That the Legal Opinion given by the Legal Advisor of the University is in consonance with the Law of the Land on the subject.

accordingly both the representations are unanimously rejected.

- 1) An Associate Professor who has completed three years of service in Academic Level 13A.
- 2) A Ph.D. degree in the subject concerned/allied/relevant discipline.
- 3) A minimum of ten research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC- listed journals out of which three research papers should have been published during the assessment period.
- 4) Evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.
- 5) A minimum of 110 Research Score as per Appendix II, Table 2.

The Screening Committee found them not eligible for promotion from Associate Professor (Academic Level 13A) to Professor (Academic Level 14) under CAS on the following grounds:

- 3) A minimum of ten research publications in the peer- reviewed or UGC-listed journals out of which three research papers should have been published during the assessment period.
- 4) Evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

Both the candidates made representations against the rejection of their candidature.



Their representations were referred for legal opinion to the Legal Advisor of the University.

The operative part of the legal opinion reads as under:

The decision of the Committee absolutely correct and the candidature of the candidates has rightly been considered and rejected bu the Committee while not considering fit them for promotion as Professors, under CAS.

The Vice-Chancellor also informed that Dr. Girjesh Shukla has submitted his withdrawal of the application as well as representation.

Dr. Ruchi Sapahia made a request to give her an opportunity for oral before the Executive hearing Council but her request was rejected as such practice has never been followed anywhere. However, anybody can make a written representation. The Vice-Chancellor informed the members about the written representation of both the candidates attached as annexures. The Vice-Chancellor also requested to consider the representations in a kind and favorable manner, as per the request of Dr. Ruchi Sapahia The Executive Council deliberated the matter thoroughly and noted that both of the candidates do not possess essential qualifications required for

- glory of knowledge and learning. In addition, the Golden Ashoka Chakra represents the national character of the HPNLU, Shimla.
- 3. Garland of Pinkish-Reddish
  Rhododendron
  represents the beautiful state of Himachal Pradesh.
  The flower is also officially the flower symbol of state of Himachal Pradesh.
- 4. The snow-covered background of the Himalayas, in the logo represents not the divine topography of the state of Himachal Pradesh but it is also greatest representatives Indian Nationhood, as it is called Sagarmatha.
- 5. Lastly, the scale of justice in its golden color at the adobe of snow-covered Himalayas, in the logo represents that Law and Legal Education has the highest value and function in anv social order. In that sense, it represents the Indian Legal System and Legal Education.
